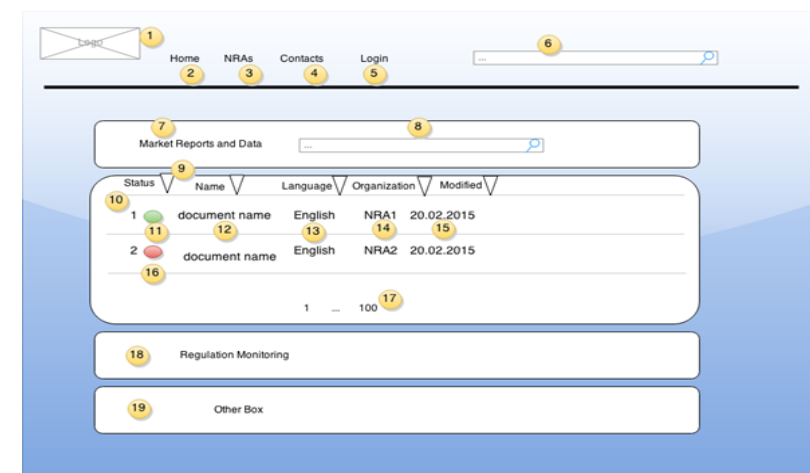
BEREC-net
