

Markus Skarohlid, LL.M.

Head of the Electronic Communications Department



Markus Skarohlid has been working as a Legal Officer at the Office for Communications (Amt für Kommunikation, AK) since May 2013. In this role, he is involved in regulatory and competition law matters in the field of electronic communications. His responsibilities include in particular the preparation and support of market analyses, regulatory measures, as well as legal support within national and international working groups. In addition, his work focuses on cybersecurity, eIDAS, trust services and domain administration. Since 2025 Markus Skarohlid is the Head of the Electronic Communications Department.

Previously, from 2003 to 2013, Markus Skarohlid held various senior positions in the Legal and Regulatory Affairs Department at UPC in Vienna. In these roles, he was responsible for regulatory proceedings, represented the company vis-à-vis the regulatory authority and acted as an expert in telecommunications law.

He began his professional career as a trainee lawyer, focusing on intellectual property, telecommunications and media law. Markus Skarohlid studied law at the University of Vienna, complemented by a semester abroad at the University of Oslo. He completed a postgraduate university programme in information law (LL.M.) in Vienna.
