

Elvis Babačić was born in Berane, Montenegro. He received his diploma degree in field of electrical engineering (study program: Telecommunications) from the Faculty of Electrical Engineering, University of Montenegro, in 2004.

Since 2005 he is with the Agency for Electronic Communications and Postal Services (EKIP), national regulatory authority in electronic communications sector, covering a range of positions, from intern, to expert for cellular radio networks and services, manager for fixed and mobile radiocommunications, up to general manager for fixed and mobile radiocommunications.

During more than 20 years of work engagement at EKIP, he worked on the most significant projects in the field of strategic planning and coordination of radio-frequencies for mobile communication networks included spectrum auctions and electronic communications regulation in general.

He acquired knowledge and experience in the field of strategic RF spectrum planning, radio-frequency allocation methods, spectrum market valuation models, industrial and regulatory trends in wireless communications, and telecommunications in general, at numerous conferences, workshops, and trainings organized by the ITU, CEPT, BEREC, IRG, and others.
