Introduction and Participation

An Extraordinary virtual Meeting of the BEREC Contact Network (CN) took place on **12 January 2021**. The Meeting was chaired by Mieke de Regt (BIPT), representative of the BEREC Chair 2021.

The Meeting was attended by senior representatives of the National Regulatory Authorities (NRAs) with primary responsibility for overseeing the day-to-day operation of the markets for electronic communications networks and services. NRAs from the EU Member States, from the EEA countries and from the States that are candidates for accession to the EU were also represented. Representatives of the European Commission also attended the Meeting.

Main Results of the extraordinary meeting of the BEREC Contact Network in 2020

The objective of the meeting was to present and discuss first ideas on the draft BEREC position paper on the Digital Markets Act and exchange preliminary remarks regarding the NIS 2 Directive. Additionally, Ad-hoc 5G Cybersecurity (5GCS) WG Co-Chairs presented two remaining PRDs from the BEREC Work plan 2021. Consequently, the BEREC Contact Network (CN) concluded the following:
