

Curriculum Vitae of Ervin Kajzinger

Ervin Kajzinger is Director of International Affairs and Strategy at the National Media and Infocommunications Authority (NMHH) of Hungary, where his main areas of expertise are expanding and reinforcing relations with local and international stakeholders, as well as coordinating the formation of NMHH's mid-term strategy and monitoring of the same.

Ervin has been co-chairing the Regulatory Framework Expert Working Group of the Body of European Regulators for Electronic Communications (BEREC) since 2015, for he took an active role in shaping the European Electronic Communications Code.

Ervin started his career at a Big Four consulting firm. Later on he held various positions in the public sector; he also worked as Deputy Head of the Department of Infocommunications and Digital Economy of the Ministry of Economic Affairs and Transport in charge at the time of the development of the Hungarian ICT strategy. After joining NMHH in 2008 he was involved in the revision of the European Telecom Regulatory Framework. Since then he has contributed proactively on behalf of the Authority to the shaping of numerous other European policy initiatives in the field of electronic communications.

He holds a master's degree in Economics from the Janus Pannonius University, Hungary; an MSc in IT Management and an MBA (both from the CEU Business School).
