

CV Tanja Muha, MSc

Tanja Muha is currently Director of Agency for communication networks and services of the Republic of Slovenia (AKOS). During 2019, she was also vice-chair at the Body of European Regulators for Electronic Communications (BEREC).

She is responsible for managing, supervising and coordinating the AKOS activities on electronic communications, post, electronic media, railways and radiofrequencies management. In last period, she is also partially involved in the electrical sector.

Mrs. Muha has experiences in regulation for more than 15 years and she started with activities practically from its foundation, firstly with being actively involved in expert working groups as a drafter in different work streams. Before she took over governance of AKOS, she was head of telecommunication department. Her educational background is economics and public law.

As AKOS is convergent regulator she has among others knowledge in the area of electronic communications, radio frequency management, market analysis procedures and remedies, net neutrality/QoS, cybersecurity, end users protection (incl. disputes), universal service, encouragement of investments (CRDirective), mapping etc. In the electronic media sector, she is responsible for the enforcement of the obligations imposed on the area of advertising, protection of minors, media and information literacy, program requirements etc. She has also a deep knowledge of railway and postal sector.
