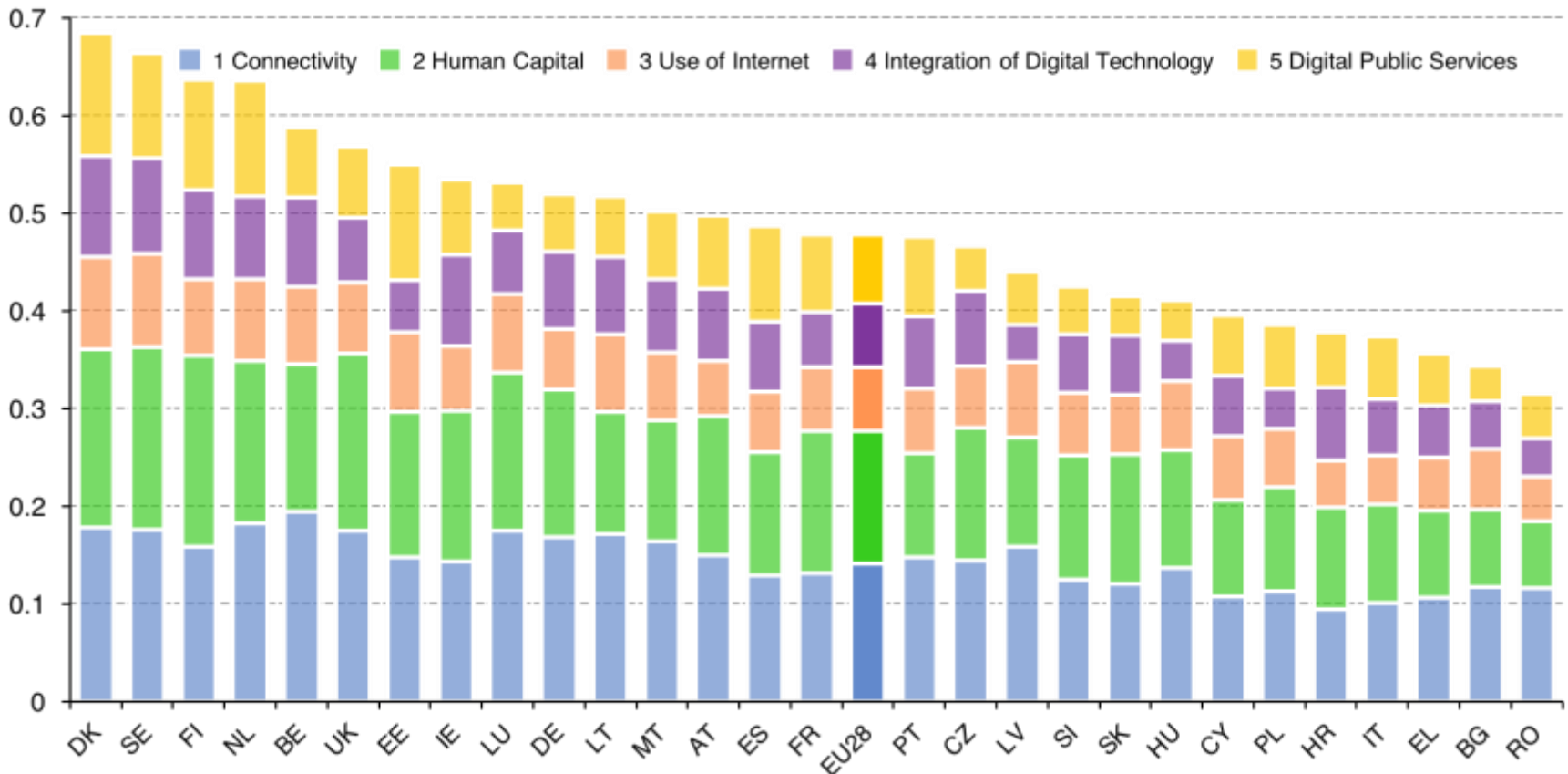

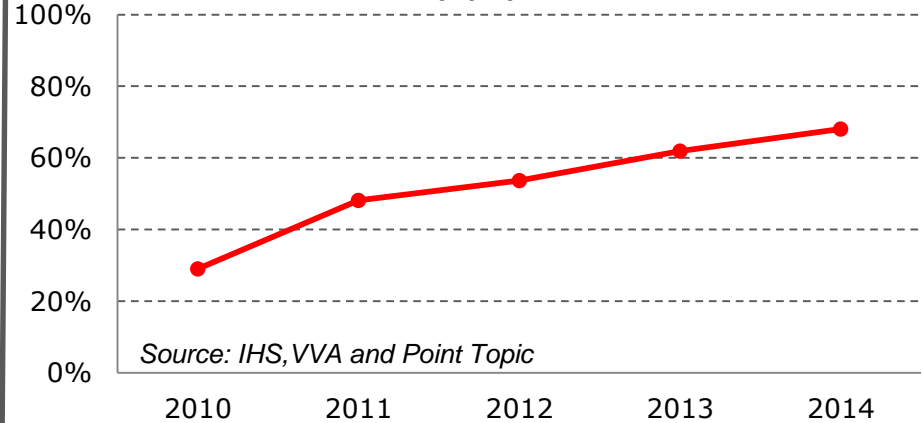
Digital Economy and Society Index



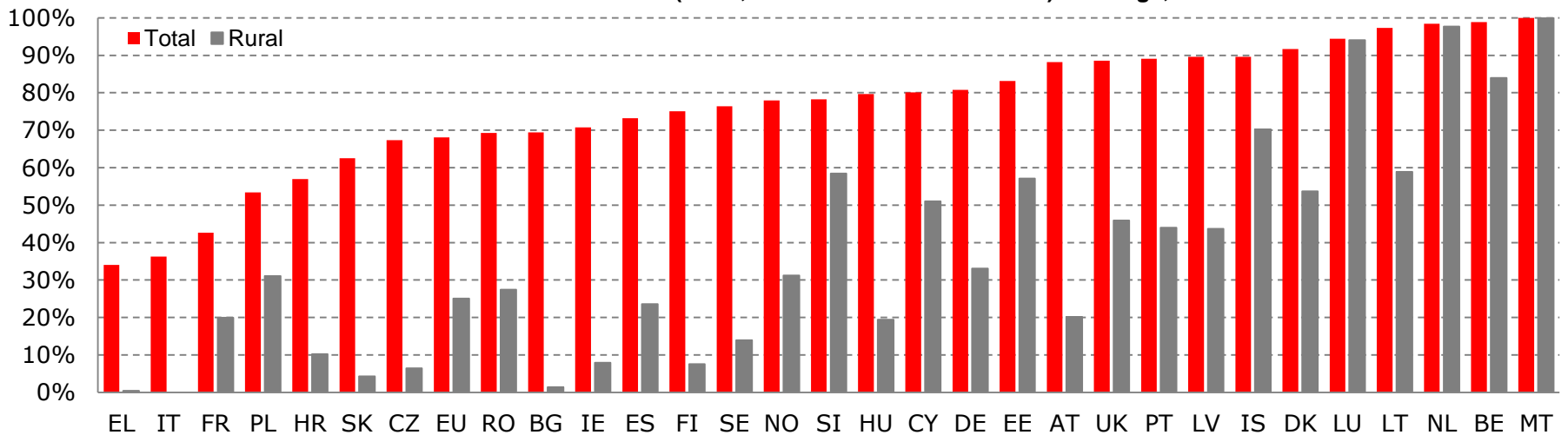


NGA networks are still very much limited to urban areas: only 25% of rural homes are covered, mainly by VDSL.

Next Generation Access (NGA) broadband coverage in the EU, 2010-2014



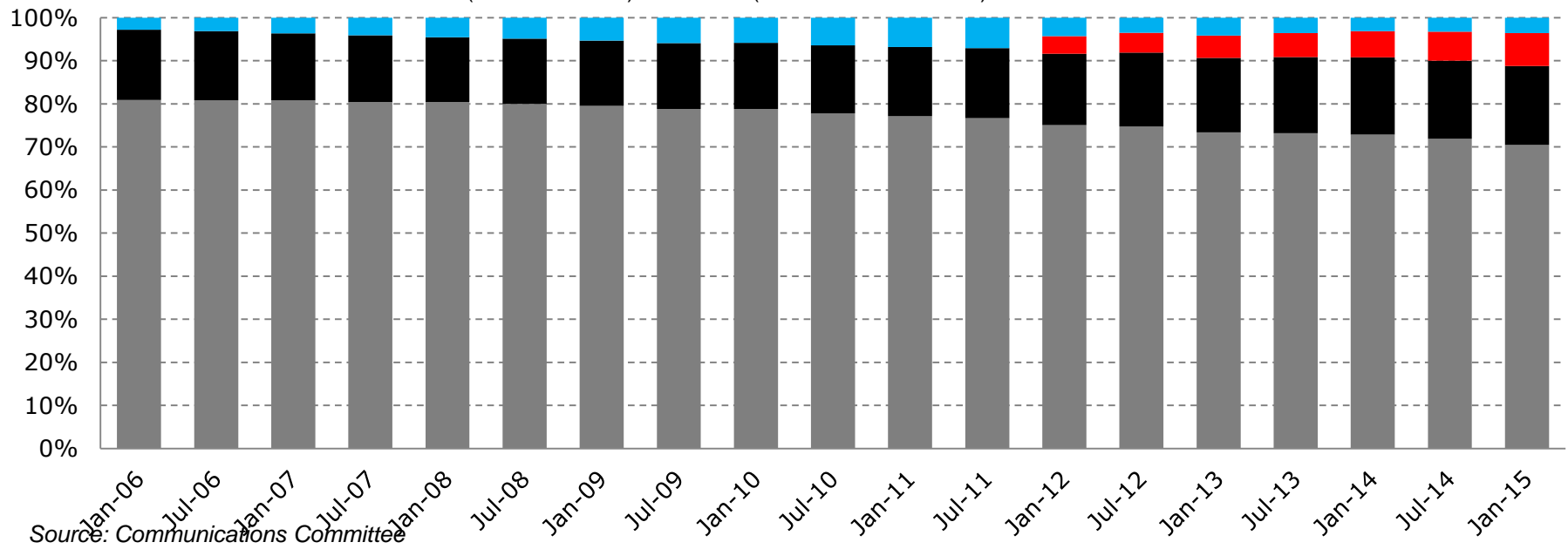
Next Generation Access (FTTP, VDSL and Docsis 3.0 cable) coverage, 2014

DSM on Telecoms reform:

- (i) consistent single market approach to spectrum policy and management**

Objectives for the telecoms market

A modern regulatory framework for electronic communications networks and services should:

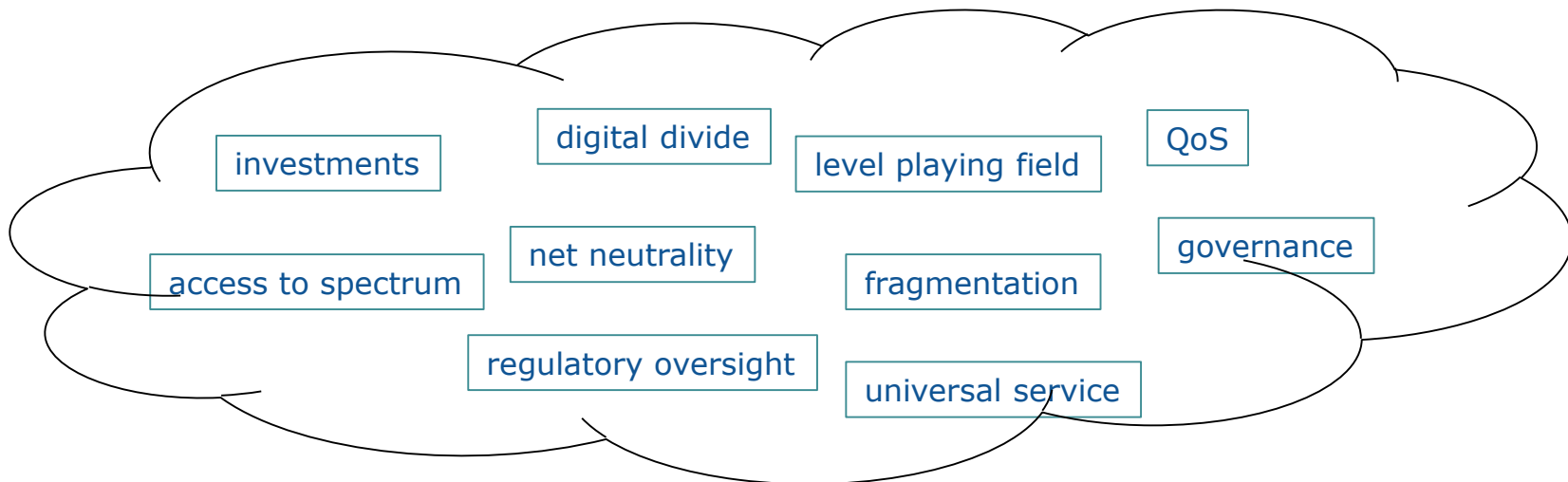
- Maintain **competition focus** – in infrastructure as well as services – to underpin **end-user benefits**.
- Incentivise **economically reasonable investments** in future-proof high-speed broadband networks.
- Enable high-capacity **connectivity to every citizen and business in Europe** (i.e. no digital divide).

We need sustainable, market-based high-performance **broadband infrastructures** (fixed and wireless) as basis for a vibrant Digital Single Market
