Main principles

- Following the BEREC Medium Term Strategy (2/2012)
 - Promote the consistent application of the European Regulatory Framework.
 - Support the DAE-2020 objectives.
 - Provide expertise and professional advice to the European Institutions.
 - Respond timely to Article 7/7a cases and any ad-hoc requests.
- Review of work midway through the year, to reassess priorities and allocation of resources.

Boosting the roll out of Next Generation Networks

Support the promotion of sustainable and efficient investment and competition in high speed broadband infrastructure and services.

- Methodology for monitoring the application of Common Positions on WLA, WBA, WLL
- Costing principles in an emerging NGA environment
 - Opinion on draft Recommendation
 - Guidelines for the implementation of the Recommendation (if needed)



Boosting the roll out of Next Generation Networks (2)

- Emerging challenges in an NGN/ NGA environment:
 - Next Generation Networks and IP interconnection
 - Effective regulation in a NGA environment
- Revise Common Position on Geographic Aspects of Market Analysis
- Continue co-operation with the RSPG, on the effective utilisation of the radio spectrum.



Costing principles in a NGA environment

- Major challenge for Regulators.
 - NRAs need to send the right signals to all stakeholders.
 - NGA networks change the market conditions and introduce increased complexity & uncertainty.
- EC announced Recommendation on key access products.
- BEREC actively participates in this dialogue: the costing principles & their implementation should contribute to enhancing competition, and encourage investments & innovation.
 - Opinion to draft Recommendation.
 - Implementation guidelines, if appropriate.



Consumer empowerment and protection

Focus on the consumers, to safeguard their interests and ensure that they profit optimally from all possibilities.

- Continue work on Net Neutrality
 - Ensure that NRAs are able to respond effectively to related developments.
 - Contribute to policy initiatives.
- Further contribute to the specification process of the Universal Service directive.
- Support end-users with disabilities and ensure equivalence of access and choice.



Net Neutrality

- BEREC is committed to the open Internet; will continue to focus on Net Neutrality:
 - Opinion on draft Recommendation on Net Neutrality.
 - Report on platforms for measuring the Quality of broadband access services.
 - Study on consumer incentives and market forces driving Net Neutrality developments.
 - Detailed specifications to implement BEREC transparency guidelines.
 - Preparation for 2nd round of Traffic Management Investigation.



Boosting the internal market

Contribute to the promotion of the internal market and to the development of competitive cross border services.

- Implementation of the Roaming Regulation III.
- Interconnection issues relating to the provision of Special Rate Services.
- Relieving restrictions to the pan-European provision of electronic communications services.
- Issues related to the development of M2M services.



Boosting the internal market (2)

- Benchmarking:
 - Benchmarks on FTR, MTR and SMS.
 - Revenue indicators in relation to bundled services.
 - Regulatory Accounting in practice report.
- Engage with EU Institutions on the implementation of the European Framework:
 - Recommendation on non Discrimination.
 - Recommendation on Relevant Markets.



International Roaming

- Contribute to the implementation of Roaming Regulation III.
 - Guidelines for the implementation of the Roaming decoupling obligation.
 - Implementation progress report (planned for 2014).
 - Roaming benchmark reports (semi-annual).
 - Report on transparency and comparability of roaming tariffs.



Other internal and external activities

Covers all activities that do not fall under the three main priority areas, whether internal or external.

- Consideration of the institutional aspects in the implementation of the European Framework.
- Support and contribute to the BEREC evaluation process.
- Amend the BEREC Rules of Procedures.
- Engage with stakeholders.
- Relations with third parties and international co-operation.
