## Regulatory framework based on guiding principles has proven successful


- Promote Competition and Investment

#### **DSM** deliverables

#### ACCESS REGIME

Different set of challenges in member states

Mix of different instruments needed

Effective competition will remain key

check regulatory toolbox to respond to fast evolving and diverse market requirements

#### **SPECTRUM**

Current framework worked well

European and global spectrum coordination already reality

Further (top down) harmonisation bears risks

Inefficient use scarce resource, hampering rather supporting innovation could be result

Analysis with a view to optimum regulatory wholesale structure with a view to ending roaming surcharges

Guidelines for implementation of net neutrality provisions

"Work in progress" at EWG level

Consultation on draft guidelines to be launched in June

**Adoption until end August**
