## BEREC Guidelines:

- **Help National Regulatory Authorities (NRAs) and Stakeholders**, like mobile operators, professional associations, financial analysts, investors, internet service providers and others;
- Provide more detailed **guidance** and explain **legal provisions** for their practical usage;
- Must be taken into utmost account by NRAs;
- Ensure **consistent application** of legal provisions in the European Economic Area.
