- Held in Brussels on January 28th, 2010
- Adopted rules of procedure
- Elected:
  - Chair 2010 – John Doherty, ComReg
  - Chair 2011, vice-chair – Chris Fonteijn, Opta
  - Vice-chair – Matthias Kurth, BNetzA
  - Vice-Chair – Reinaldo Rodriguez, CMT
- Agreed to consult on 2010 work programme

- Vacancy note for the position of BEREC Office Administrative Manager published in OJ 3 March Journal
- Recruitment process for a Head of Administration and Finance and Financial Assistant will commence shortly

## 2010 Work Programme

- Public consultation on Work Programme held 9th February to 2nd March
- ERG 2010 Work Programme used as foundation for first BEREC Work Programme
- Consistency and continuity in transition from ERG to BEREC essential

## Project Team Structure

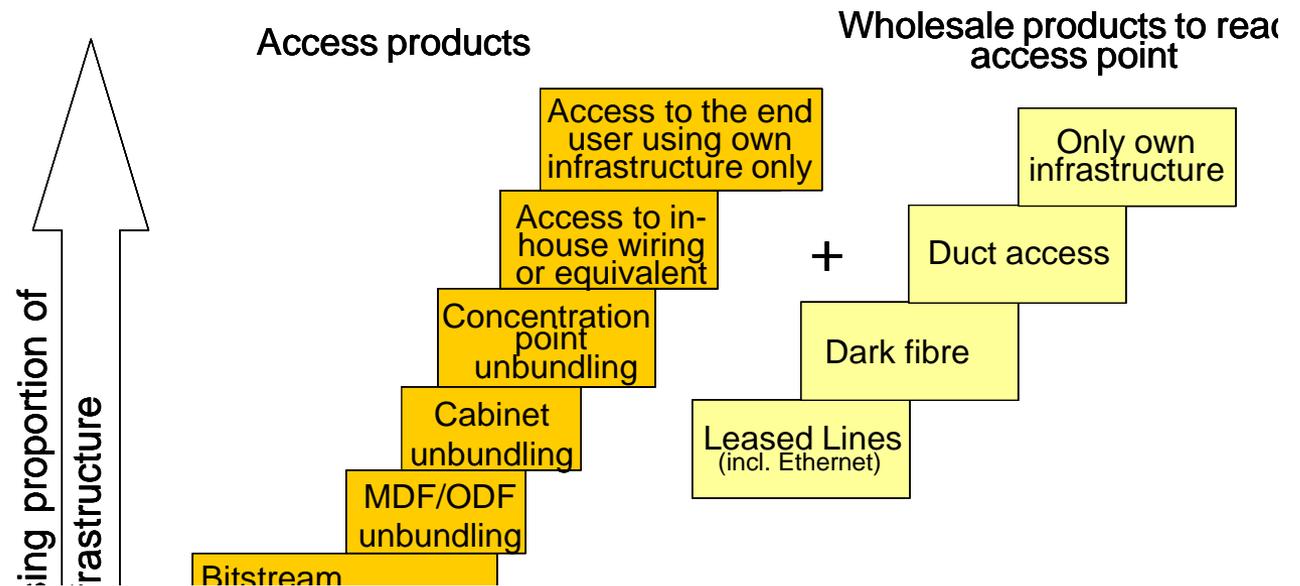


# February BoR Meeting Work Programme progress

## **Next Generation Access: Implementation Issues and Wholesale Products**

- Report approved for publication
- Follow-up to the ERG Common Position on NGA 2007
- Report outlines situation at end 2009 in terms of roll-out scenarios, product definitions and regulatory issues
- Looks at best practice examples reflecting early stage of regulatory decision making regarding NGA wholesale products.
- “Ladder of investment” as starting point; relevance of different ladder rungs and wholesale products depending on scenario (FttC, FttH).
- Generally more own infrastructure where access point closer to the end-user

# February BoR Meeting: WP progress cont'd

## Report on Self Supply by Convergence and Economic Analysis PT

- A descriptive report on the issue of self-supply relating to market analysis focussing on wholesale broadband market
- How NRAs have taken self supply issues into account?
- Findings:
  - Most NRAs addressed self supply at both the market definition and market analysis stage
  - The report found that inclusion/exclusion of self supply has not affected the final outcome of market analysis

# **February BoR Meeting: WP progress cont'd**

## **International Roaming – Progress Report**

- Two reports on International Roaming were approved for publication
- The first examined the state of compliance with the new requirements which came into effect in July 2009
- Overall high level of compliance with requirements. Also looks at status of implementation for future requirements, particularly 'bill shock' protection.
- The second report examined the availability of roaming tariffs other than the Eurotariff
- Factual report giving an overview of more than 330 reported tariffs provided by over 75 operators from 24 countries.
- Exercise will be repeated to discern trends

## **February BoR Meeting ERG 2009 Annual Report**

- The meeting adopted the 2009 ERG Annual Report
- The report has been submitted to the European Commission for forwarding to the European Parliament and Council
- The Report will be published after it has been sent to the Institutions
