



Prof. Dimitris Varoutas, Chair

Dimitris Varoutas is the Chair of Hellenic Telecommunications and Post Commission (EETT) and served as Vice-President for Electronic Communications since 2020.

He is Professor at the Department of Informatics and Telecommunications of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens (UoA), where he has taught since 2005. He holds a Jean Monnet Chair in European Digital Policies, awarded by the European Union in 2025. His research focuses on telecommunications networks, technoeconomic analysis, and ICT infrastructure regulation, areas in which he has accumulated over 170 publications in peer-reviewed journals and conferences. He has participated in numerous EU- and nationally funded R&D projects since 1993 and has advised public bodies including EETT and the Greek Government on broadband and mobile network policy. A Senior Member of IEEE, he is a frequent invited speaker at international organizations on broadband development and telecommunications policy.

He holds a degree in Physics, a postgraduate diploma in Electronics/Radio Engineering, and a PhD from UoA.
