

## Ms. Lena Nyberg

Director General of the Swedish Post and Telecom Authority (PTS)



Ms. Lena Nyberg was appointed Director General of the Swedish Post and Telecom Authority (PTS) in May 2026.

She is a senior executive with more than three decades of experience at the intersection of telecommunications, digital transformation, cybersecurity, and national security. Her career spans both government and international private sector leadership, with a strong focus on strategic governance, large-scale operations, and international collaboration.

Prior to her current role, Ms. Nyberg served as Deputy Director General of the Swedish Defence Research Agency (FOI) from 2021 to 2026, where she contributed to strengthening Sweden's defence research and innovation capabilities.

She previously held senior executive positions in global and Nordic companies, including Chief Delivery Officer at Universum Group and Senior Vice President Global Services and CIO at DigitalRoute, where she led international operations across multiple continents and drove digital and organisational transformation at scale.

Between 2009 and 2015, Ms. Nyberg served as Director SIGINT at the Swedish Signals Intelligence Agency (FRA), with full responsibility for signals intelligence operations, including cyber threat analysis and extensive international cooperation in security and intelligence domains.

She has also held leadership roles at Teracom Boxer Group, Logica (CGI), Telia, and several technology companies, building deep expertise in electronic communications, critical infrastructure, and advanced digital services.

Ms. Nyberg has contributed to public policy and governance as a member of the Swedish Government's Expert Panel for Digitalization and through board assignments at the Swedish National Debt Office (Riksgälden) and the Swedish Post and Telecom Authority.

She holds a Bachelor of Science in Mathematics and Computer Science from Uppsala University.
