

Professor Dimitris Varoutas

Vice President for the electronic communications sector

Professor Dimitris Varoutas is the Vice President for electronic communications of the Hellenic Telecommunications & Post Commission (EETT) since February 2020.

He serves as an Associate Professor in the Department of Informatics and Telecommunications of the School of Science at the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens - UoA . He has been appointed as Member of Board of the Hellenic Authority for Communication Security and Privacy from 2007 to 2016.

Professor Dimitris Varoutas has been participating in numerous European R&D projects in the areas of telecommunications and technoeconomics since early 90s. As a UoA faculty member he also participated in or managed national projects and initiatives related to technoeconomic evaluation of broadband strategies, telecommunications demand forecasting, price modelling etc. His research interests span design of optical and wireless communications systems to technoeconomic evaluation of network architectures and services.

He has published more than 120 publications in refereed journals and conferences in telecommunications, optoelectronics and technoeconomics, including leading IEEE journals and conferences. He is a Senior Member of IEEE and participates in several societies including Communications, Photonics (former LEOS), Education and Engineering Management. Also, he serves as Editorial Board member and reviewer in several journals and conferences, including those of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE).

Professor Dimitris Varoutas holds a Physics degree, MSc, and PhD diplomas in communications and technoeconomics from the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens.
