

**Mr. TOMI FRASHËRI – Chairman, Electronic and Postal Communications Authority (AKEP)**

Born in Tirana, Albania, in 1983, Tomi Frashëri earned a high school diploma in foreign languages at the Tirana's School of Foreign Languages (2001), before being admitted at the Law Faculty of the Université Paris II – Panthéon-Assas (2002) where he was awarded a Master Degree in French Public and Administrative Law and where he came out as a *Major de Promotion* and Laureate of the Paris's Law Faculty in 2007 (Dissertation: "*Droit administratif de la preuve et nouvelles technologies de l'information et de la communication*").

After spending three years as a researcher at the same university (*Institut Cujas*), he joined in 2010 the French Ombudsman Administration in Paris (*Défenseur des droits*) as task officer (*chargé de mission*) in charge of the due process of law in administrative and public services litigation cases.

In 2014 Tomi Frashëri was invited to join the Cabinet of the Prime Minister of Albania, Mr. Edi Rama, as a Diplomatic Adviser and Chief of Protocol, position he has been holding till December 2019. During his activity alongside the Prime Minister he has been instrumental in managing bilateral as well as multilateral State, Official and Working visits and has contributed extensively to the successful outcome of many international negotiation processes, while assisting significantly in the drafting of the legislative reform of the State Ceremonial Framework.

Between 2017-2018, Tomi Frashëri also organized the Pan-National Year of Skanderbeg in Albania, in his capacity of Chairman of the Technical Secretariat, during which a large number of major projects, especially in infrastructure and education, were launched across the country.

In December 2019, he was elected Chairman of AKEP by the Parliament of Albania.

Tomi Frashëri is the author of many scientific publications relating to Public Law and History, and has been awarded in Economic and Sociological Sciences by the Institut de France (*Académie des Sciences Morales et Politiques* – 2002). He is member of the General Assembly of the Charles de Gaulle Foundation in Paris and of the Young Academy of Albania.
