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The Satellite Sector adds value for Europe



Serving the EU:

TV - Broadband - Disaster Management - Development - Maritime Communications - Security - Energy Efficiency - Climate Change

- EU is the hub of the global satellite industry:
 - ⇒ Operators, launchers, manufacturers, insurance...
- Significant economic contribution:
 - ⇒ Recent Booz&Co report identified direct & indirect contribution of 200,000 highly skilled jobs, €10bn revenue with growth potential to €100bn for EU economies
- Private investment today for the future:
 - ⇒ Euroconsult figures indicate approximately 200 GEO satellites are on global order to 2021 = almost \$70bn of satellite operator investment alone
- ESOA members deliver value-added services:
 - ⇒ Oxford Economics found that satellite operators investments provide a massive multiplier in the downstream space sector
 - ⇒ Euroconsult found that every €1 of public investment into satcoms generates €47 of downstream turnover!

DAE 2013 OBJECTIVE: SATELLITE BB IS AVAILABLE THROUGHOUT EU28

- Offers go up to 20Mbps broadband access
 + very often include triple play
- Over 2,000 TV & radio channels
- Example price for 20Mbps: around €29.90 per month
- ⇒ Satellite helps EU regions to achieve 100% broadband coverage
- ⇒ E.g. Auvergne: 2009 Regio Star Award for Broadband" from DG REGIO

Satellite leads the way in transmission in the latest digital formats: HDTV/ UHDTV/ 3D TV

Delivering Linear TV anywhere: The *core Satellite strength*

Consumers demand content on all devices:

TV content delivered via satellite can be viewed on multiple devices thanks to new satellite standards

- Satellite brings bandwidth-hungry content to the network edge closer to users, so relieving the load on terrestrial networks
- Hybrid solutions such as satellite + WiFi optimise cost & spectrum efficiency

⇒ RSPG	 Several opinions & reports of relevance to satellite: spectrum demand or broadband wireless 6 GHz, interference management, LSA, WRC- 15, etc.
⇒ RSCom	 Drafted EC harmonisation decisions of high relevance to satcoms, e.g. 2008/144 /EC on BWA in C Band or 2007/98/EC on MSS 2 GHz
⇒ CEPT	 EFIS & EC Inventory Harmonisation of licensing rules across 48 countries (e.g. ESOMPs)
