1. BEREC Intranet Concept Paper

The MC discussed the BEREC Intranet Concept Paper and approved it to be used as a basis for preparation of the tender documentation for the launch of the procurement for the deployment of the system. The document will not be published.

2. BEREC Office Staff Policy

The MC discussed some burning issues related to the BEREC Office staff policy, such as the recruitment of seconded national experts (SNEs) and ensuring international schooling for the children of the BEREC Office staff, and decided to follow-up on these issues during its next meeting.

3. Recruitment of the BEREC Office Administrative Manager (AM)

The MC discussed the next steps for the selection of the BEREC Office AM.

IV. Next meeting

The next meeting of the BEREC Office MC will take place on 5 and 6 December 2013 in Budapest (Hungary) and will be hosted by the <u>Hungarian National Media and Infocommunications Authority -</u> <u>NMHH</u>.

The BEREC Office MC held its 16th meeting on 27 September 2013, Riga (Latvia), kindly hosted by the <u>Latvian Public Utilities Commission</u> - SPRK, in cooperation with the BEREC Office. The meeting was attended by high-level representatives of the National Regulatory Authorities (NRAs) with primary responsibility for overseeing the day-to-day operation of the markets for electronic communications networks and services established in each EU member state and the Commission. Representatives of the NRAs from the EFTA states and the states that are candidates for accession to the EU also took part in the meeting and were represented at high level.

The meeting was presided by Dr Leonidas KANELLOS, President of the Hellenic Telecommunications and Post Commission (EETT), BEREC Chair 2013.

The Chairman of the BEREC Office Staff Committee made a short presentation on the situation of recruitment of SNEs and the proposed way ahead. The MC was informed that in the opinion of the Staff Committee one of the barriers to successful recruitment of SNEs is the lack of information. Therefore the BEREC Office will prepare an information package (including with description of the SNE's functions) which could be presented to potential SNE candidates in those NRAs willing to second experts to the BEREC Office.
