 - Could not take them on board, due to resource constraints (mainly the Connected Continent proposal).
 - Mid year review may allow undertaking new work streams.

BEREC Work Programme 2014 - overview

- Prioritization is necessary due to the work on the Connected continent proposal.
- Transparency is important and we will continue to improve this during 2014.
- The WP is following themes of Medium term strategy – Infrastructure, Consumer empowerment, Internal market and Horizontal and quality aspects.
- An additional theme is Digital single market including the Commission Connected continent proposal, which will potentially influence all work and work streams 2014, and the Recommendation on relevant markets.
- BEREC Office essential to the success of the WP.
