BEREC Strategy 2015-2017

- **Trends affecting BEREC**
- **Market developments**
 - OTTs, M2M, bundled services, network convergence, quality of service, investments in NGN, mobile offload, data protection and privacy, market consolidation, cross border mergers
- **Regulatory developments**
 - “The most significant regulatory development is likely to be the review of the European regulatory framework”

BEREC strategic documents and internal governance

- **BEREC working to improve efficiency - three important documents**
 1. BEREC Strategy 2015-2017 – adopted for public consultation – to be discussed at Stakeholder Forum 16 October in Brussels
 2. BEREC Working Structure – to be adopted at next plenary meeting and implemented in 2015, more transparency, Vice-Chairs to have a bigger role
 3. BEREC Work Programme 2015 – adopted for public consultation, also at BEREC Stakeholder Forum

BEREC Strategy 2015-2017 - three strategic pillars and priorities

1. Promoting competition and investment
 - Promoting competition
 - Fostering a favourable climate for investment
 - Supporting innovation

2. Promoting the internal market
 - Supporting convergence
 - Taking down barriers

3. Empowering and protecting end-users
 - Promoting end-user choice accessibility and affordability
 - Safeguarding an open internet
 - Promoting end-user protection online
