- MoU with Euro-Mediterranean Regulators Group (EMERG) approved for signature
- Approved for public consultation a report on monitoring the quality of Internet access services in the context of net neutrality
- Initiated work on opinion on Commission proposal of review of relevant markets
- Decided to hold a 2nd stakeholder forum in Brussels in October
- Mr László Ignéczi was appointed Administrative Manager of the BEREC Office. Mr Ignéczi takes up his duties 1st April 2014

BEREC Report on Monitoring quality of Internet access services in the context of net neutrality

- Aims to establish a basis for the creation of Internet access service quality monitoring systems covering two main use cases:
 - A:** Providing transparency for end users
 - B:** Regulatory supervision with regard to potential degradation of service.
- Recommendation on what systems to use and what metrics to look at
- Recommends an evolutionary approach to a potential multi-NRA opt-in monitoring system
- It is further recommended that BEREC conducts a feasibility study for a potential future opt-in monitoring system
- Report approved for Public Consultation
