

DECISION № MC/2014/7

of the Management Committee of the Office of the Body of European Regulators for Electronic Communications (BEREC Office) to approve the proposals for the appointment of a HR Officer and the establishment of a reserve list (TA – Grade AD5) of the BEREC Office

The Management Committee of BEREC Office,

HAVING REGARD to the Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Union and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/68 and the amendments thereto, and in particular Articles 43 and 110 of the Staff Regulations, and Articles 15(2) and 87(1) of the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants;

HAVING REGARD to Regulation (EC) No 1211/2009 of 25 November 2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing the Body of European Regulators for Electronic Communications (BEREC) and the Office (hereinafter "Office"), and in particular Articles 7 and 10 thereof;

HAVING REGARD to the Decision by the Management Committee of the BEREC Office on the general implementing provisions on the procedures governing the engagement and the use of Temporary agents at the BEREC Office (MC (10) 23); and in particular Article 3 (3) and Article 3 (6) thereof.

Whereas the Selection Committee appointed for the recruitment of the HR Officer was composed by the listed members:

- Ms Veronique Brigitte BAGGE – Head of Administration and Finance Unit, Chair of the Selection Committee;
- Mr Michele CHIODI – Legal Officer;
- Mr Fabrice ANDREONE – Staff Committee representative from the European Commission.

Whereas the appointed Selection Committee agreed on a report on 7 May 2014;

Whereas the Selection Committee suggested the appointment of:

Mr Pablo AGUIRREZABAL JAUREGUI as successful candidate for the post of HR Officer;

Whereas the Selection Committee suggested to create a reserve list of three candidates in order of merit for the post of HR Officer;

HAS ADOPTED THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

To approve all proposals suggested by the Selection Committee and agree that the Vice Chair appoints the HR Officer and adopts the reserve list.

The reserve list shall be included in an Annex to the Decision of the Vice Chair of appointment.

The reserve list shall be adopted in order of merit and with validity 12 months from the date of its establishment. Its validity may be extended by Decision of the Vice-Chair of the Management Committee prior to its expiration.

The present decision shall enter into force on the day of the signature.
