Question 1:

Since a participation in the above mentioned public procurement procedure is not open to tenderers from countries, which have ratified the Multilateral Agreement on Government Procurement (GPA), an interested economic operator has raised a question if it is eligible to participate.

A company registered in one of the EU Member State is a subsidiary, not a branch office, but fully functioning limited company operating independently and separately from its US parent (the USA has signed the GPA).

Answer 1:

If the entity registered in one of the EU Member States has an independent legal personality that is established and registered in Europe as a fully functioning limited company, it may have access to the BEREC Office procurement procedure.
