TRAINING ON THE REGULATORY FRAMEWORK FOR ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS NETWORKS AND SERVICES AND OTHER TOPICS RELATED TO BEREC ACTIVITIES

Question 1:

In the call there is no mentioning of the duration (in weeks) of the online training. It is specified that it should be 2-3h per week, but we miss the specification about the number of weeks.

Answer 1:

Number of weeks between the blocks of the residential training is not specified. This number depends on how frequent the residential training blocks shall be organised and may vary, e. g. due to public holidays. There shall be no more than 1 residential training block per month. The online tutorial aims to accompany the training and provide a possibility to prepare for the residential training with preparatory readings and do a follow-up exercises after each of the training blocks.

It is up to the tenderer to provide a detailed training content and schedule including one for the online tutorial, allocating the time to all lessons and activities. The provided schedule will be evaluated as one of the award criteria for the tender.

Question 2:

The on-line courses should be delivered over a live web-casting during predetermined time-slots, or they should be available on the web (password protected) so that each course participant can follow them on their own pace? The different methods imply different costs for preparation/production of the online courses.

Answer 2:

The online tutorial shall take place between the blocks through an online platform. Each participants should have an access to such platform and be able to do the preparatory and follow-up activities on the online platform. The online platform might be organised on the website of the tenderer and be part of the access protected area of that website. It is entirely up to the tenderer to propose, establish and manage the online platform paying though due attention to **Item 4.3 of the Technical Specifications**.

Question 3

Who is the owner of the IP for the courses? Is the tenderer or BEREC? Again this choice implies different costs.

Answer 3:

Question 4:

When do you expect that the training should start?

Answer 4:

At least one residential training shall be organised still in 2016, e.g. during the period October – December 2016.
