Question 1:

Regardless of how much experience potential trainers have, if their degree is not viewed as being within the narrow number stated in the Technical Specification, the tender will be seen as non-compliant and rejected?

Answer 1:

The selection criteria will be used to select the tenderers. In case the requirements indicated as "selection criteria" are not met, the offer will be rejected.

According to the Tender Specifications, tenderers must prove their economic, financial, technical and professional capacity to carry out the work subject to this call for tender.

All the factors will be viewed and assessed as per criteria indicated in the Technical Specifications. Professional experience is one of the standards that will be checked and assessed together with other indicated standards.

The lecturers must meet the following standards:

- (1) Degree in <u>economics</u>, <u>legal and/or engineering</u>, or the latter <u>related to electronic</u> <u>communication</u> <u>or in a field corresponding to the nature of the training</u>, and
- 2) <u>Professional experience of minimum 5 years</u> in at least one of the above-mentioned fields and/or teaching experience of minimum 3 years.
