Introduction and Participation

The 1st meeting of the BEREC Contact Network (CN) for 2018 took place on **7 and 8 February 2018 in Bonn** (Germany), kindly hosted by the German <u>Federal Network Agency</u> (BNetzA). The meeting was chaired by **Elisabeth Dornetshumer** – International Affairs Manager (RTR) and representative of the BEREC Chair 2018, **Johannes Gungl** – Managing director of RTR (Austria).

The meeting was attended by senior representatives of the national regulatory authorities (NRAs) with primary responsibility for overseeing the day-to-day operation of the markets for electronic communications networks and services. NRAs from the EU Member States, from the EEA countries and from the States that are candidates for accession to the EU were also represented. Representatives of the EFTA Surveillance Authority (ESA) and the European Commission also attended the meeting.

Main Results of the 1st meeting of the BEREC Contact Network in 2018

The objective of the meeting was to prepare the 34th ordinary plenary meetings of the BEREC Board of Regulators (BoR) and the BEREC Office Management Committee (MC), due to take place on 7 and 8 March 2018 in Bratislava (Slovak Republic). Consequently, the BEREC Contact Network (CN) considered all possible topics to be included in the BoR and MC agendas and concluded the following:

The BoR will be briefed on the recent activities of the BEREC Chair, important projects carried out by the BEREC Office in support of BEREC, as well as recent and forthcoming BEREC international activities. The European Commission will also be invited to provide the BoR with information on recent important developments and activities related to the telecommunications framework review. The BEREC members will exchange views on the ongoing review and will share experience on the implementation of Net Neutrality rules. The BEREC Chair will reflect on requests for access to documents. The BoR will also discuss the process for the BEREC Work Programme 2019.
