# Guidance for accessing the BEREC public technical workshop on IPv6 deployment across Europe (19 May 2021)

The BEREC workshop will be live-streamed using a specially designed live-streaming platform – Vbrick. To ensure accessibility, participants can:

- Change the screen size for the presentation and for the active speaker
- Ask live questions to the speakers using the Q&A box

## How to use the live-streaming platform

- Open the link to the livestream provided on the BEREC website.
- Choose your Display name, preferably in the format of Name Surname (Organisation), and provide your email address.
- Choose "Sign in as guest".

## How to watch and interact with the livestream

- Use the button on the right side of the video window to change the layout of your view you can choose to watch only the speakers, only the presentation, or mix both.
- By clicking on the information (i) button on the right side to open the 'Event Details' section, you will be able to find the link to any relevant documents and/or details.
- Toggle the speaker button on the right side of the video window to hear the sound.

#### How to ask live questions to the speakers

- You can ask questions by clicking the Q&A button (?) on the right-side menu. By submitting the question, the event host will be able to see your Display name.
- Your question is public for all the other event attendees to see it as well.
