

Decision No MB/2024/04
of the Management Board of the Agency for Support for BEREC (BEREC Office)
to establish Working Arrangements between the NRAs of Ukraine and the Body
of European Regulators for Electronic Communications (BEREC)

The Management Board,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2018/1971 of 11 December 2018 establishing the Body of European Regulators for Electronic Communications (BEREC) and the Agency for Support for BEREC (BEREC Office), amending Regulation (EU) 2015/2120 and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1211/2009¹ ("the BEREC Regulation") and in particular Article 35 thereof;

Having regard to Decision MB (19) 95Rev.1 Rules of Procedure of the Management Board of the BEREC Office;

Whereas

1. Working Arrangements are required to be put in place by Article 35(2) of the BEREC Regulation;
2. The Board of Regulators, the Working Groups and the Management Board shall be open to the participation of regulatory authorities of third countries with primary responsibility in the field of electronic communications, where those third countries have entered into agreements with the Union to that effect;
3. Agreement with the Union in accordance with Article 35(2) of the BEREC Regulation is in effect with Ukraine;
4. Pursuant to Article 35(1) of the BEREC Regulation, on 19 January 2024 the European Commission has provided its approval² on the establishment of such Working Arrangements;
5. The BEREC Office is keen to develop and maintain good and productive relationships with the NRAs of third countries;
6. The BEREC Office is determined to strengthen the relationship between the NRAs by means of increased engagement and regulatory policy dialogue and wish to enter into working arrangements.

Has adopted the following Decision:
