

Decision MB/2026/07

of the Management Board of the Agency for Support for BEREC for applying by analogy of Commission Decision C(2026)634 final of 5 February 2026 on the general provisions for implementing Articles 110(2) of the Staff Regulations

The Management Board,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union, laid down in Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/68¹, and in particular Article 110(2),

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2018/1971 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2018 establishing the Body of European Regulators for Electronic Communications (BEREC) and the Agency for Support for BEREC ('BEREC Office'), amending Regulation (EU) 2015/2120 and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1211/2009², and in particular Article 16 (j),

Having regard to the Rules of Procedures of the Management Board of the BEREC Office and in particular Article 2 thereof,

After consulting the Staff Committee³,

Whereas:

- (1) On 5 February 2026, the European Commission adopted Decision C(2026) 634 final, amending Decision C(2002) 98, which sets the rates of daily subsistence allowances and the ceilings for the reimbursement of hotel expenses for missions outside the European territory of the Member States of the European Union. The Decision was notified to the BEREC Office on 6 March 2026 in accordance with the procedure laid down in Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations. It entered into force for the European Commission on the date of its adoption, 5 February 2026.
- (2) The above-mentioned Decision amends Decision C(2002) 98, which sets the rates of daily subsistence allowances and the ceilings for the reimbursement of hotel expenses for missions outside the European territory of the Member States of the European Union, in order to include provisions for daily subsistence allowances and hotel expense ceilings for missions carried out in the United Kingdom.
- (3) In line with the Staff Regulations, the Commission staff implementing rules apply by

analogy to the agencies. These take effect at the agencies nine months after entering into force at the Commission or after the Commission notifies the agencies, whichever is later. Nevertheless, the agency may decide that such implementing rules are to enter into force at an earlier date.

- (4) At the moment of the notification the BEREC Office was applying Commission Decision C(2002) 98 of 16 January 2002 which fixes the daily subsistence allowance and hotel ceiling for missions taking place outside the European territory of the Member States of the European Union. Therefore, it would be reasonable to apply also the Decision C(2026) 634 final, amending Decision C(2002) 98 as of the date of its entry into force for the Commission.
- (5) In line with the procedure envisaged in Article 110 of the Staff Regulations, the BEREC Office Staff Committee was consulted and gave favourable opinion on the implementation of Decision C(2026)634 final of 5 February 2026 by analogy⁴,

Has adopted the following decision:

Article 1

Application by analogy

Commission Decision C(2026)634 final of 5 February 2026 on the general provisions for implementing Article 11(1), and Article 13(2), point (b) of Annex VII to the Staff Regulations of Officials and authorised travel shall apply to the BEREC Office by analogy.

Article 3

Entry into force

This Decision shall take effect on 5 February 2026.
